Presentation of Public Management, Inc.’s Town Hall Meeting Findings

Levi Hancock with Public Management, Inc., presented council with the Community Town Hall Findings from the meeting that was conducted in November 2025. With community feedback, it was determined that economic growth and resilient infrastructure rank dramatically higher than all other themes. It was also determined that housing reinvestment, i.e. vacant or deteriorated homes, roadway conditions, drainage system improvements and economic opportunity are needed.
